Floral aromas with hints of lemon zest lead to flavors of grapefruit, lemon, pear, honeysuckle and vanilla. The bright fruit and crisp acidity of the wine make it a pleasure to drink alone or to pair with light cheeses, smoked salmon and lemon-rosemary chicken.

Stonecap wines are made entirely from estate grown grapes from the renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This expansive (1300 acres) and highly regarded vineyard allows the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

Washington State's famed Columbia Valley produced extraordinary grapes in large part due to the area's great soils, the result of massive flooding during the last Ice Age. Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "stonecap" of rocks behind.
