



Stonecap Chardonnay 2007 Columbia Valley

Our 2007 Stonecap Chardonnay is full of tropical fruit, citrus, pear and apple flavors. Creamy vanilla and hints of spice add to the structure of this crisp and clean wine. Our Chardonnay is perfectly paired with grilled poultry, light cheeses and salads.

This Chardonnay was fermented in stainless steel and cold stabilized before bottling.

Stonecap Wines are made entirely from estate grown grapes from the renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This highly regarded vineyard allows winemaker Charlie Hoppes and the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

Washington State's famed Columbia Valley produces extraordinary grapes in large part due to the area's great soils, the result of massive flooding during the last Ice Age. Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "Stonecap" of rocks behind.
