The Stonecap 2007 Syrah is soft and smooth with bold dark berry and plum flavors that fill your mouth. Toasty cedar, smoked meat and hints of tobacco and cocoa blend to create a complex and ready to drink wine. Perfect with grilled meats and game bird, this wine will also pair well with heavy cheeses.

Stonecap Wines are made entirely from estate grown grapes for the renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This highly regarded vineyard allows winemaker Charlie Hoppes and the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

- Grapes harvested on November 1, 2007
- Crushed and spent 5 days on skins to allow maximum flavor profile before fermentation
- Pumped over twice a day
- pH at bottling: 3.93
- Total acidity at bottling: .55
- Alcohol: 14.0%
- Varietal: 100% Syrah
- Cases produced: 3370

Washington State's famed Columbia Valley produces extraordinary grapes in large part due to the area's great soils, the result of massive flooding during the last Ice Age. Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "Stonecap" of rocks behind.
